## **Market Commentary**

## **WOOL MARKET 2,3% LOWER**

Port Elizabeth - The wool market traded lower at this weeks auction and the Cape Wools Merino Indicator decreased by 2,3% and by 533 points to close at a value of R223,95/kg (Clean). The Australian EMI lost 1,5% this week. The Cape Wools All Wool Indicator declined 2,4%.

The wool market traded softer this week primarily due to mediocre market demand for long and fine Merino Wool, buoyed by a strengthened Rand. Prices decreased across the board with the fine and coarse ends of the market recording the greatest losses. 96% of a fair sized offering was sold.

Modiano bought the most bales at the auction today.

This week saw the Rand at R14,36 to the US Dollar and R16,60 to the Euro. The Rand was 0,4% weaker against the US Dollar and 1,3% stronger against the Euro, compared with the average rate at the previous sale. The offering comprised 7 653 bales of which 97,6% was sold. Major traders were Modiano (2 804), Standard Wool SA (1 576), Tianyu SA (1 424) and Stucken & Co (889).

The average clean prices for the selection within the different micron categories for good top-making (MF5), long fleeces were as follows: 18,0 microns decreased 3,6% to close at R264,86/kg; 18,5 microns moved 2,2% down to close at R256,60/kg; 19 microns lost 2,9% to close at R246,60/kg; 19,5 microns weakened by 2,0% to close at R244,13/kg; 20 microns was 2,9% weaker to close at R230,85/kg; 20,5 microns lost 3,4% to close at R225,91/kg; 21,0 microns lost 2,3% to close at R230,60/kg; 21,5 microns decreased by 3,2% to close at R221,98/kg; 22 microns decreased by 2,0% to close at 222,89/kg and 22,5 microns declined by 4,0% to close at R225,24/kg.

The next sale is scheduled for 10 October 2018 where approximately  $\pm 6$  323 bales will be on sale.
